AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the funding of
approved special education programs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-
bly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 4405 of the education law is
2 amended by adding a new paragraph j to read as follows:
3 j. Notwithstanding any provision of law or regulation to the contrary,
4 for the purposes of establishing tuition rates for the two thousand
5 seven--two thousand eight school year and thereafter, the commissioner
6 shall develop a tuition rate setting methodology, pursuant to this para-
7 graph, whereunder the costs associated with pedagogical and clinical
8 staff and personnel are adjusted to be a minimum of the equivalent of
9 ninety percent of the regional median salary of such staff and personnel
10 in the public educational employment sector as determined by the commis-
11 sioner, and approved by the director of the budget.
12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after
13 it shall have become a law; provided, however, that the commissioner of
14 education is immediately authorized and directed to promulgate any rules
15 and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this act on its
16 effective date.
