



**Medicaid in Education
The New Medicaid Compliance Program
Presented by the New York State
Education Department**

On Tuesday, November 24th, Hal Matott, from the New York State Education Department, Office of Operations and Management Services Medicaid-in-Education, will be presenting, to Eastern Suffolk BOCES districts, new Medicaid requirements that school districts must adhere to.

The requirements to be discussed are:

- Medicaid Compliance Program Mandatory for districts who order, provide, bill or claim \$500,000 or more from Medicaid in a 12-month period.
- Confidential Disclosure Policy Mandatory for **all** districts.
- Certification Training Mandatory Medicaid Certification for **all** “relevant employees”
