On that SAMS Snapshot the 2021-22 Aidable Excess Cost amounts reported on Line 12 of the 2021-22 PRI State Aid Output Report and Line 7 of the 2021-22 PUB State Aid Output Report should be very close in value to the Aidable Excess Cost totals listed at the end of each school district EFH277 2020-21 Private STAC Approval Listing and EFH277 2020-21 Public STAC Approval Listing (see filenames in above box).
